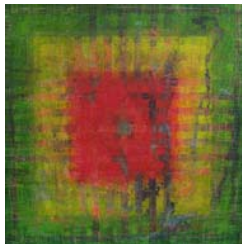

Omar Rodriguez portraiture work was featured in the 2006 Ford and Smithsonian exhibition of *Retratos: 2000 Years of Latin American Portraits* at the San Antonio Museum of Art.
